Certificate of Composition - Parish of Kilmacdonagh

I Walter Lindsay Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second & third years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the fourth entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 1st, 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the fourth providing for the establishing of Composition for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising growing yielded and payable within the parish of Kilmacdonagh in the County of Wick do hereby certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is ~~Five Pounds~~ Twelve Pounds Fifteen Shillings by the year of which sum of £12-15-0 Two third parts are due and payable to the Rev^d Thomas Linn as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector or Prebendary of the Prebend of Kilmacdonagh and One third part is due and payable to the Rev^d John Leslie the Vicar of said parish.

And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of Seven Years ending on the first day of January 1834 is One pound twelve Shillings and One halfpenny per Barrel
