the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth -
intituled an act for the Establishing of Compositions for
tithes in Ireland for alimited tithes to Ascertain and fix
all such and Just Compositions for all tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the parish of Hillmacowen
being a Member of the Perpetual Union of Saint John
Tithes in the County of Sligo, do Certify that the true and
Just Amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is one hundred and ninety five
Pounds sixteen Shillings and five pence by the year of which
Sum of one hundred and ninety five pounds sixteen Shillings
and five pence the whole and entire amount is due and
Payable to the Rev^d Charles Hamilton as a Composition for
the tithes claimable by him as Rector and Rector of the
said Parish and We do further Certify that the average
Price of oats being the sown principally sown in such
County for the Period of seven years ending on the
first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one is seven Shillings and two pence farthing

twenty ninth day of April 1824
