Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix
the true and just Compositions for all Tithes arising growing
yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmacowen
being a Member of the Perpetual Union of Saint John
the Kings Majesty of Great Brittain do hereby certify that the true and
just Amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever
within the said Parish is one hundred and ninety five
Pounds sixteen Shillings and five pence by the year of which
Sum of one hundred and ninety five pounds sixteen Shillings
and five pence the whole due and payable is due and
payable to the said Parish as a Composition for
the Tithes Claimable by him as Rector and Rector of the
said Parish and We do further certify that the average
Price of oats being the most principally sown in such
County for the Period of seven years ending on the
first day of November one thousand eight hundred
and twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing
per Barrel Given under our hands at Saint this
twenty ninth day of April 1824
