We Joseph Smith and Ignatius Moore Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of King George the fourth Entitled "An act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding & payable within the parish of Kilmaculaway in the County of Dublin do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said parish is now one hundred and eighty four pounds twelve shillings and four pence Sterling by the year agreeably to the assent of the Bishop of the Diocese and the agreement between the Parishioners of said Parish and the Incumbent of same as certified to us by Bryan Mackell Esquire Chairman of a special Vestry held in said Parish on the sixteenth day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven for the purpose of carrying into effect the said Act the whole of which sum of one hundred and eighty six pounds twelve shillings and four pence is due and payable to the Reverend John Reade as a Composition for the Tithes claimed by him as Incumbent of the said Parish and we do further Certify that the average price of wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County for the period of seven years ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is one pound Eighteen shillings and eight pence halfpenny per Barrel late Irish Currency being one pound fifteen shillings and eight pence three farthings present Currency as appears by the returns from the Dublin Gazette.
