

We, Julius M^o Hugh and George Dodwell Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an
Act made in the fourth Year of the Reign of King
George the fourth, entitled "an Act to provide for the
Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for
limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and just
Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielding, or
payable, within the Parish of Kilmactoge in the County
of Sligo, do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said
Parish is Three hundred and fifty Pounds by the
Year, and which sum is payable to the Rector of the
said Parish - and we do further Certify that the average
price of Oats, being the Corn principally grown in the
said County of Sligo, for the period of seven years
ending the first day of November one thousand eight
hundred & twenty one, is fifteen Shillings & two pence
farthing for Barrel.
