Tithes in Ireland for a limited time "to ascertain and fix a true and
just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielding or payable
within the Parish of Kilmactige in the County of Sligo, do hereby
certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whatsoever within the said Parish is Three Hundred and fifty pounds by
the year and which Sum is payable to the Rector of the said Parish
and We do further certify that the average price of oats, being the
corn principally grown in the said County of Sligo, for the period of
Seven years ending the first Day of November One thousand Eight xx
Hundred and Twenty one is fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing
per barrel
