

We the Rev Melton Gifford and William Telford J of Greenville  
 Commissioners duly appointed and sworn by virtue of an Act made in the fourth  
 year of the Reign of King George the Fourth Entituled An Act to provide for  
 the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time,  
 also of an Act made in the Fifth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth  
 Entituled An Act to amend an Act of the last Session of Parliament to  
 provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, to  
 ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes, arising  
 growing, yielded, or payable, within the Parish of Kilmanagham in the  
 Kings County and County of West Meath, being part of the Union of  
 Ardmore, Do hereby Certify that an Agreement bearing date the  
 17<sup>th</sup> of April 1826 was entered into on the part of the Marquess of  
 Downshire and the Marchioness of Downshire by their agent Thomas  
 Murray Esq to accept of the Sum of One hundred and forty seven  
 pounds thirteen Shillings and ten pence one farthing by the year for  
 twenty one years as a Composition for the Rectorial Tithes claimable by  
 him from the said Parish of Kilmanagham. And that an Agreement  
 bearing date the same 17<sup>th</sup> of April 1826 was entered into by the  
 Rev George Leslie Gifford Vicar of said Union of Ardmore to accept  
 of the Sum of One hundred pounds by the year for twenty one years as a  
 Composition for the Vicarial Tithes claimable by him from the said  
 Parish of Kilmanagham. We therefore hereby further Certify that the  
 true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within  
 the said Parish of Kilmanagham is Two Hundred and forty seven  
pounds thirteen Shillings and ten pence one farthing by the year  
Of which Sum of two hundred and forty seven pounds thirteen  
Shillings and ten pence one farthing One hundred and forty  
seven pounds thirteen Shillings and ten pence one farthing is  
due and payable to the Marquess and Marchioness of Downshire as  
Lay Impropriators. And One Hundred pounds is due and  
payable to the Rev George Leslie Gifford as Vicar of said Union  
of Ardmore
