

We Christopher Bayly and Joseph Baldwin Commissioners duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the
fourth year of the reign of ^{King} George the fourth. Intituled an act to provide
for the establishing of Composition for Tythes in Ireland for a limited
time, to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all the
Tythes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of
Kilmanmon in the County of Wick do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tythes whatsoever within the
said Parish is Three Hundred and Seven Pounds. by the year
of which sum of Three Hundred and Seven Pounds, the sum of one
Hundred and Seventy one Pounds six Shillings and eight Pence
are due and payable to General Edward Dunne as a Composition
for the Tythes claimable by him as Impropriate Rector of the
said Parish, and Eighty five Pounds thirteen Shillings & four pence
is due and payable to the Rev. Thomas Lyott the Vicar of the
said Parish, and Fifty Pounds is due and payable to the
Rev. John Baldwin Curate of the perpetual Curacy of Glenashel
in said Parish - and we do further Certify that the true
amount of the Tythes of said Parish for seven years ending
November the first One Thousand eight Hundred and Twenty
one is Two Hundred and Eighty eight Pounds Five Shillings
and eight pence - and we have added the sum of Eighteen pounds
fourteen Shillings and four pence to said average, and the grounds
and reason for our adding such sum is to compensate the Curate
of the perpetual Curacy of Glenashel for the loss he would sustain
by such Composition under this act - and we do further
Certify that the average Price of oats being the corn princi-
pally grown in such County for the period of seven years
ending November the first One Thousand eight Hundred and
Twenty one is Fifteen Shillings and two pence farthing per Barrell
given under our hands in the Parish Church of Rosenallis
this Thirtieth day of October one Thousand eight Hundred
and Twenty Three
