The Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the 4th year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a given time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes growing, arising, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kilmaogue in the County of Kildare, do hereby certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred and forty five pounds fourteen Shillings and one penny Sterling -

Which sum of Two Hundred and forty five pounds, fourteen Shillings and one penny Sterling is due and payable to The Very Rev^d: Arthur Preston, as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish. And we do further certify that the Average Price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years next preceeding 1821 was One pound eighteen Shillings and eight pence Halfpenny per Barrel.
