

We The Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act made in the 4<sup>th</sup> Year of The Reign of King George The Fourth. intituled, "An Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited Time", to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within the Parish of Kilmacogue in the County of Wicklow, do here by certify, that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is two hundred and forty five pounds fourteen shillings and one penny Sterling —

Which Sum of two hundred and forty five pounds fourteen shillings and one penny <sup>is due</sup> ~~sterling~~ and payable to The Very Rev<sup>d</sup>: Arthur Preston as a Composition for the Tithe claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of said Parish. And We do further certify that the Average Price of Wheat, being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of Seven years next preceding 1828 one. is one pound eighteen shillings and eight pence half penny per bush —
