amount of Compensation for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said parish is one Hundred and twenty six
pounds seven shillings British Currency by
the year, the said sum of one Hundred and twenty six
pounds seven shillings being issued and payable
to the Rev. Owen Gallivan a curate in the said
parish, who is Vicar of the said parish, namely
the sum of sixty three pounds seven shillings, and also
the sum of sixty three pounds seven shillings being also
paid to the Incorporated Society as a Compensation for
the same to be paid.
