*Sci* Whereas under and by virtue of a certain Act of Parliament passed in the fourth fifth and seventh and eighth years of the reign of His late Majesty George the fourth for the Composition of Tithes in Ireland that part of the lands of Ferbragg and Lissamuskay situate in the parish of Kilcogan alias Kilmain Barony of Athlone and County of Roscommon which is in the occupation of me and my under tenants is charged and chargeable with the yearly sum of Four pounds four shillings and ten pence Sterling One half or moiety of which said sum has been paid and is now payable to the Incorporated Society for the Maintenance of Protestant Schools Now I hereby offer and undertake to pay to the said Incorporated Society the moiety or half of said sum in such manner and subject to such obligations and immunities as is or are recited in one other Act of Parliament passed in the second and third years of His present Majesty's reign for the permanent composition of Tithes in Ireland And you are further to take Notice that I hold from Edward Winder Kelly Esquire of Ballymurray in said County the aforesaid Lands of Ferbragg and Lissamuskay under and by virtue of a Lease for three years with a Covenant therein for the perpetual Renewal of said Lease and that said Lands are measured and bounded as follows on the North by the Ruins of the Church of Kilmoy in alias Kilmoyne the lands of Taborin now the Dower of the Right Honorable Lord Crpton and the lands of Tuicaron on the South by the Lands of Kilrogh alias Kilcosh on the East by part of the lands of Liffinick and on the West by the boundaries of the said of Ferbragg so held by the said Edward Winder Kelly Esquire in lieu of his right of commonage on said Lands Given under my hand this twelfth day of February One thousand eight hundred and thirty three
