

Set forth in said Certificate - And Whereas
the said Applicants and the Reverend Edward Jones Alcock the
present Rector of said Parish having appeared by their Counsel
or Agents before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions, and
the said Notice of Application, Certificate and the average price
of wheat as advertized in the Dublin Gazette for the said period
of Seven years having been proved. Now The said Justices
do ascertain from the said Gazette that the average
price of wheat for the said period of Seven years is One Pound
Ten shillings and Three pence halfpenny Sterling for each Banel
of Twenty stone - And The said Justices do accordingly
order and adjudge that the amount of said Composition in said
Parish and the Rent charges payable in lieu thereof shall be
diminished in proportion to the difference between the said
average price of One Pound Ten shillings and Three pence and
halfpenny Sterling for the said period of Seven years and the
average price stated in the said Certificate of Composition, and
that the applotment of such Composition shall be amended
accordingly And The said Justices do further
order, that said Reduction shall take effect from the
first day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Fifty six -
