made in the Fourth year of the reign of King George the Fourth  
intituled "An act to provide for the establishment of composi-  
tions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time" to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising,  
growing, yielded and payable within the Parish of Milneen in  
the County of Cork, do hereby certify, that the true and just  
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within said  
Parish is Seven Hundred and Fifty Pounds by the year of  
which Seven Hundred and Fifty Pounds the whole is  
due and payable to the Reverend Edward Herbert Sturmy  
as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector  
of the said Parish. And we do further certify that the  
average price of wheat being the corn principally grown in  
such County for the period of seven years ending on the first  
day of November one Thousand eight hundred and Twenty one  
was one pound eighteen shillings and eight pence halfpenny  
per barrel -
