an act made in fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth intituled "An Act to provide for
the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and
Just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing,
paid or payable within the parish of Millinewan
in the County of Kilkenny, do hereby Certify that the
true and Just amount of Composition for all
Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Sixty
Pounds British by the Year of which sum of Sixty
Pounds British the Entire is due and payable
to the Rev^d Thos^d Kearney as a Composition for
all Tithes claimable by him as Rector and Vicar
of the said Parish. And we do further Certify
that the average price of Wheat being the Corn
principally grown in such County for the Period of
seven years ending on the first day of November
1821 is One Pound fifteen shillings and
Eight pence three farthings British per Barrel
dated the 20th day of April 1826 Six
