We Stephen Wright and John Dunne Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of
an Act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King
George the fourth intituled "An Act to provide for
the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true
and Just composition for all Tithes arising,
growing, Yielded, or payable within the Parish
of Kilmenan in the County of Kilkenny, do
hereby Certify, that the true and Just amount of
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the
said Parish is Sixty Pounds British by the
Year of which Sum of Sixty Pounds British
the Entire is due and payable to The Rev^d
Tho. H. Kearney as a Composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Rector and Vicar of the
said Parish. And We do further Certify
that the average price of Wheat being the Corn prin-
cipally grown in such County for the Period of Seven
Years ending on the first day of November 1825 One
is One Pound fifteen shillings and eight pence three
farthings ^{British} per Barrel - dated this 28th day of
April 1826 Six.

The said Vestry do hereby give their assent to the Composition
agreed upon on the 16th of September 1825 on behalf of the owners
& occupiers of land in the Parish of Kilmenan & do also signify
their consent that such Composition shall be invariable for the term
of twenty one years, & shall not be subject to any variation in the
amount thereof during such period of 21 years, ~~under~~ under
the provisions of the 4th Geo IV Chap 99 & the 5th of Geo IV Chap 63 -
