for the establishing of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for
a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable within
the Parish of Kilmeachan County and Diocese of Cork
do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Compositions
for all tithes whatever within the said Parish is six Hundred
and ninety two Pounds six Shillings and two Pence British
Money ~~and~~ which sum is due and payable to the
Reverend Robert Warren, as a composition for the tithe
claimable by him as rector and vicar of the said Parish
and we do further certify that the average price of Wheat
being the corn principally grown in the said County is
one Pound eighteen and eight Pence ~~halfpence~~ halfpenny
per Barrel, for the seven years ending the first of November
1825 twenty one
