And also that the average price of wheat during the seven years preceeding the first day of November 1820 was one pound twelve shillings and one half penny per barrel, and that the average price of oats during the same period was twelve shillings and eleven pence half penny per barrel; wheat and oats being the Corn principally grown in the said County of Cork.
