

to apply as prescribed by law to the justices appointed to keep the Peace for the County of Cork assembled at the next ensuing General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for the said County of Cork being the County in which the said Parish of Kilmichael is situated that is to say to the justices of the Peace assembled at the General Quarter sessions of the Peace to be held at Macroom in and for Cork County West Riding and Division of Macroom on the 12th day of October 1876 and at the General Quarter sessions to be held at Bandon in and for Cork County West Riding and Division of Bandon on the 19th day of October 1876 to have the average price of wheat and the average price of oats for the seven years preceding said application inquired of and ascertained from the Dublin Gazette and in the manner prescribed by law in order that the said Composition for tithes and the rent charge payable in lieu thereof in and for the said Parish of Kilmichael may be varied and diminished or increased for the seven years commencing and ensuing the first day of November 1876 in proportion to such average prices and to have the apportionments of said Composition and Rent Charge amended and altered accordingly and if necessary to have an arbitrator appointed to ascertain such average

average prices of wheat and oats respectively and have all proper and lawful directions given and orders made for the purposes aforesaid as to the said justices shall seem meet.
