Do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all tithes what ever within the said Parish as agreed for by Special Vestry held by Adjournment in the Parish Church of said Parish on the Twentieth day of April Ins<sup>t</sup> is Six Hundred and Ninety two Pounds Six Shillings and two pence British Currency by the year for the term of Twenty one years are due and payable to The Rev<sup>d</sup>. Robert Warren Rector and Vicar of the said Parish and to Commence from first day of May next Dated this 29<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1826
