made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the fourth
(entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of Composition of
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time) to ascertain and fix a true
and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable
within the Parish of Melmolash in the Diocess of Lismore and County
of Waterford do hereby certify that the true and just amount of Composition
and Value for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Two Hundred
thirty two pounds ten Shillings British by the Year of which sum of Two Hundred
and thirty two pounds ten Shillings two third parts thereof are due and payable
to the Venerable Archdeacon Philip Ryan as the Value for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of said Parish and one third part of said sum of
Two Hundred and thirty two pounds ten Shillings British is due and payable
to the Rev^d Henry J. Williams as a Composition for ^{the} Tithes claimable
by him as Vicar of said Parish and we do further certify that John
Griffin and Michael Coghlan hold by a lease or written Document the
rectorial Tithes of said Parish under the said Venerable Archdeacon
~~Philip Ryan~~ of which a certain term of two or three years
is yet to come and is unexpired and which rectorial Tithes they
hold at the annual rent of one Hundred and Twenty nine pounds
four Shillings and seven pence half penny British and we do certify
that the average price of oats being the Corn principally grown
in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day
of November 1821 is fourteen Shillings and one farthing British per
Barrell - given under our hands this 10th day of January
