

be increased according to such average price as compared with the price of One pound five per Barrel being the price of wheat set forth in said Certificate

And Whereas the said Applicant having appeared by his Agent before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions, and the said notice of application, certificate, and the average price of wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette for the said period of seven years having been proved Now the said Justices do ascertain from the said Gazette that the average price of wheat for the said period of seven years is £1.9.0. Sterling ——— for each Barrel of twenty stone, And the said Justices do accordingly order and adjudge, that the amount of said composition in said Parish (and the Rent Charges payable in lieu thereof shall be increased in proportion to the difference between the said average price of One pound nine shillings sterling for the said period of seven years and the average price stated in the said certificate of Composition, And that the applotment of such composition shall be amended accordingly, And the said Justices do further Order that said increase shall take effect from the first day of November 1855.
