County of Cork; do here by certify that the true
and just amount of Composition for all Tithes
whatsoever within the ^{sa} Parish is Five hundred
pounds by the year which sum of Five hundred
pounds are due and payable to the Rev^d Francis
Langford as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of the ^{sa} Parish -

And We do further certify that the average
price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in
such County for the period of seven years ending
on the 25 day of December 1826 is
per Barrel One Pound
Five Shillings
