 twenty seventh day of September 1825 for the parish of
 Kilmacoge being part of the Union of St. Michael under the
 provisions of the Statute of George the Fourth Chapter 99. entitled
 an act to provide for the establishment of a corporation in Ireland
 for a limited time in order to continue superintending under that
 Statute do certify that the copy of the Certificate of Incorporation
 entered into between the said parish of Kilmacoge & the
 Rev. Henry Madras on the part of the Incumbent the Reverend
 Archdeacon Thompson, & that at the vestry held this day for
 said parish the Special vestry men whose names are here
 unto subscribed & signed said Certificate of Incorporation &
 reported & approved of said Certificate of Incorporation on behalf
 of the owners & occupiers of land in the said parish & have
 agreed that said Corporation of annual payment of the
 hundred & sixty pounds be discharged for the term of twenty
 one years & shall be available & take effect for and from
 from the first day of November next.

 provisions of the 24th George 4th Chap 99. entitled
 an act to provide for the Establishing Corporation
 for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time do certify
 that the Parishioners of Kilmacoge in the Diocese

 have agreed to pay the Reverend Archdeacon
 Thompson Incumbent of the same the annual
 sum of one hundred and sixty pounds as
 the amount of Corporation for the vectorial Tythes
 of the said Parish to remain invariable for
 the term of Twenty one years and that the
 same has been accepted in behalf of the
 said Incumbent the Reverend Archdeacon
 Thompson by the Reverend John Henry Madras
 appointed to act for him and that the
 same has been approved of and agreed to
 by the Bishop of the Diocese.
