for the tithes claimable by him as Lay Propri-
etor of the said Parish.

And I do further Certify that the aver-
age price of wheat, being the Corn principal-
ly grown in said County of Cork for the period
of seven years ending on the first day of Novem-
ber 1836 Thirty, is One pound, Twelve Shillings & One
half penny Sterling per barrel, as published in the
Dublin Gazette.
