

the true and just composition for all tithes  
whatsoever within the said Parish is Two  
hundred and Thirteen pounds, nineteen shillings  
and Ten pence Half by the year. - of which  
213 19.10 and Ten pence Half of the year. - of which  
sum of Two hundred and Thirteen pounds  
nineteen shillings and Ten pence, the sum  
of One hundred and forty seven pounds  
thirteen shillings and Ten pence is due and  
payable to the Reverend the Archdeacon  
of Cork as a composition for the tithes  
claimable by him as Vicar of the said  
Parish; and the sum of Sixty Six pounds  
Six shillings is due and payable to the  
Right Honble. The Earl of Shannon  
as a composition for the tithes claimable  
by him as lay Proprietor of the

said Parish.

And I do further Certify that  
the average price of Wheat, being the Corn  
principally grown in the said County of Kerry  
for the period of seven years ending on the  
first day of November 1830 Thirtiety, is One pound  
two shillings and one halfpenny Half per  
bushel, as published in the Dublin Gazette.
