

Certificate of Composition of Tithes

We Robert Williams, & Jonathan Nugent,
Commissioners duly appointed & sworn, under
& by Virtue of an Act made in the fourth
year of King George the Fourth, intituled
"An Act to provide for the establishing
of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a
limited time (19th July 1823) to ascertain & fix
a true & just composition for all tithes
arising, growing, yielded, or payable within
the Parish of Kilmore in the County of Meath
do hereby certify, that the true & just amount
of Composition for all tithes whatever within
the said Parish is Three Hundred & Fifty eight
Pounds, five Shillings, & five pence $\frac{1}{2}$ Sterl.
by the year. Which whole sum is due & payable
to the Rev. William Gorman, as unanimously
agreed between him & a Vestry holden on
Oct. 27th 1823, Nineteen Voters being present, as
a Composition for Tithes claimable by him as
Rector of said Parish. And we do further certify,
that the Average Price of Wheat, being the
the Corn principally grown in this County
for the period of seven years ending 1st Nov. 1821
is £1:18:8 $\frac{1}{2}$ per Barrel
