

## Certificate of Composition

I Robert Williams, Commissioner duly appointed & sworn, under & by virtue of an Act made in the fourth year of King George the fourth, intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time (19<sup>th</sup> July 1823) to ascertain & fix a true & just composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmore in the County of Meath. I hereby certify that the true & just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever, within the said Parish is Three Hundred & Fifty eight Pounds, five shillings by the year. Which whole sum is due & payable to the Messrs William Gorman, as a Composition, agreed by him & Vestry unanimously Oct. 27<sup>th</sup> 1823
