within the said Parish is Two Hundred and Sixty  
Pounds Sterling per year of which Sum of Two  
Hundred and Sixty Pounds Sterling One Half  
part is due and payable to The Reverend Thomas  
Sutton, for the Tithes claimed by him as Rector of the said  
Parish, and the other One Half part is due and  
payable to The Reverend William Paul Dawson  
as Owner of the vicarial tithes of the said parish
