

I, John McAndrew Commissioner duly appointed
and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in
the second and third years of the Reign of King William
the fourth entitled an act to amend three acts passed
respectively in the fourth fifth and in the seventh and
eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George
the fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions
for tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions
permanent) to ascertain and fix a true and just Com-
position for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Kilmore Inis County of Mayo and
Diocese of Killala. do hereby Certify that the true and
just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is Two Hundred and sixty
Pounds Sterling, per year of which sum of Two Hundred
and sixty Pounds Sterling, one Half part is due and
payable to The Reverend Thomas Sutton for the Tithes
Claimed by him as Rector of the said Parish, and the
other one Half part is due and payable to The
Rev^d William Paul Dawson as owner of the vicarial
tithes of the said Parish,

And - do further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Corn principally grown in the said
County of Mayo for the period of seven Years, ending
on the first day of November, One Thousand Eight
