Commissioner duly appointed & sworn under the Statute  
of an Act made in the 22<sup>d</sup> Year of the Reign of his present  
Majesty King Geo. the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled an Act to amend three  
Acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Years of the Reign  
of his late Majesty King Geo. the 3<sup>rd</sup> providing for the establishing  
of Composition in Tithes in Ireland & to make such Composition  
permanent; to ascertain & fix a true & just Amount of Com-  
position for all Tithes arising from any ground or hay field within  
the Parish of Kilmore in the County of Wexford. do hereby

Certify That the true & just amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is Four Hundred  
& Fifty Three pounds two Shillings & eight pence halfpenny  
by the Year - of which sum of £453. 2. 8<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>

Three Hundred & Thirty seven pounds seven Shillings  
& eight pence halfpenny are due & payable to John G. Young  
Esq<sup>r</sup> / Dep<sup>y</sup> of Mr. Genl. Colclough Esq<sup>r</sup> Dep<sup>y</sup> of the late  
Genl. Ratford Horse Esq<sup>r</sup> as owner of the Metrical Tithe  
And One Hundred & fifteen pounds fifteen Shillings  
are due & payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Thomas Gore the Vicar of  
said Parish

And I do further Certify, that the average  
price of Oats being the Corn principally sown in such  
County for the period of seven Years ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> day  
of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1830 is Twelve Shillings & Seven pence halfpenny  
per Bsh.
