

**Call to whom** these Presents shall come, I, the Reverend *Mathew Baker*  
*Incumbent of the Parish of Kilnorgan*  
in the County of Sligo, send greeting, WHEREAS pursuant to the Provisions of an Act passed in the second and third years of his present Majesty King William the 4th, intituled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth, Fifth, and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," *George Dodswell of Keshmish in the County of Antrim*  
has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, in the words and figures following:  
*Authority of Sir Robert Gordon Bart* the words figures following  
SIR,

You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the 2nd and 3rd Years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th, and in the 7th and 8th years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent," I *George Dodswell of Keshmish in the County of Antrim*  
agent to an *Esq. Sir Robert Gordon Bart*  
who is seized in *Fee simple* of all that and those the Townlands

of Lisdooogan, Taranee, Doonmeargan, Ardree, &  
Cloonygashell, containing one Thousand four hundred  
and fifty three Acres, English Statute Measure or thereabouts,  
the means and bounds whereof are delineated and set forth  
on the map, *Terre chart* hereto annexed, and which  
lands are situate in the Parish of Kilnorgan Barony  
of Corran County of Sligo

do hereby signify to you by the authority given unto me and on behalf  
of the said *Sir Robert Gordon Bart*  
desire to agree for and undertake the payment of the Composition for Tythes  
lawfully payable for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant to the said  
*Sir Alexander Crichton* a Certificate in writing conformable to the Provisions of the said Act, declaring  
him entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other mat-  
ters on your part required by the said Act to be done.
