of Tithe Composition for the Parish of
Kilmoyly, Co. Kerry

We George Rowan & Robt. D. Stokes Esqs
Commissioners duly appointed & sworn, under
& by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth & Fifth
years of the Reign of King George the Fourth,
to ascertain, & fix a True & Just amount of
Composition, for all Tithes whatever, arising,
growing, yielded, or payable, ⁱⁿ the
Parish of Kilmoyly, Diocese of Limerick
Ardfert & Aghadoe, in the County of Kerry.

Do Certify, hereby, that the True & Just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish, is Four Hundred & Fifty Pounds
St. by the year, of which sum of Four Hundred & Fifty
Pounds St. One Hundred & Fifty Pounds St. per Annum
is due & payable to Christopher Willoe Esq. as
Lessee of the Lord Bishop of Limerick, as a
Composition for all Tithe claimable by him as
vicar of the said Parish, & the remaining Three
Hundred Pounds St. per Annum, is due & payable
to Mr. Thos Rice, as under Lessee of the Right
Honble The Earl of Cork, as a Composition for
all Tithe claimable by him as Lay Impropriator
of the said Parish - And we do further certify
that the average price of oats, being the corn
principally grown for the period of seven years,
ending the first day of Novr. 1824, was fifteen shillings
& Two pence per Barrell of Fourteen Stone, certified by us
this 7th Day of Sept. 1827 & Twenty seven.
