 We William Welsh and M. Nelson duly sworn
 and sworn, under and in virtue of an act, made in the
 fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth
 entitled an act to provide for the establishing of tithes
 for tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and
 a true and just composition for all tithes arising growing
 and payable within the Parish of Kilmurry, Diocese of Meath
 and County of Clare - do hereby certify that the
 and just amount of composition for all tithes within
 the said Parish is eighty five pounds ten shillings by
 year, of which sum forty five pounds ten shillings are
 and payable to the Vicar of the said Parish, as Vicar of the said
 tithes of said Parish, and that the sum of forty pounds
 are due and payable to the Vicar M. Miller as a recompense
 for the tithes claimable by him, as the Vicar and
 Incumbent of the said Parish - the first payment
 to become due 8th day of May 1825
