

We William Welch and Daniel W. Mehan duly appointed and sworn, under and by Virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the fourth entitled an Act to provide for the establishing of composition for tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain and fix a true and just composition, for all tithes arising growing, yielded and payable, within the Parish of Bilmurry, in the County of Clare and Diocese of Killaloe.

Do hereby certify that the true and just amount of composition for all tithes within the said Parish is eighty five pounds ten shillings by the year, of which sum, forty five pounds ten shillings, are due and payable to the Rev. Rich. Shedd as Rector of the Rectorial tithes of said Parish, and that the sum of forty pounds are due and payable to the Rev. W. Miller, as a composition for the tithes claimable by him, as the Vicar and incumbent of the said Parish.
