£130 is thereby found to be due and  
payable to Dundow Scott Lay Impropriator  
as the Composition for Tithes claimed by  
him as Lay Impropriator of said Parish  
and the remaining sum of £95 is  
thereby found to be due and payable  
to the Rev<sup>d</sup> James Martin the Vicar of  
said Parish and it was certified that the  
average price of Oats being the corn  
principally grown in said Parish for  
the period of seven years ending the
