

I John Kidd Commissioner duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the second and third years of the Reign of his Majesty King William the Fourth entitled "An Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth Fifth and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmurry in the County of Cork, Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish of Kilmurry is Eight Hundred and Thirty Five Pounds Seven Shillings and one Penny by the year, which Sum is due and payable to his Grace the Duke of Devonshire as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Lay Impropriator of said Parish. — And I do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County during the period of the Seven years ending the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty is One Pound Twelve Shillings and one Halfpenny per Barrel, and that the average price of Oats during the same period is Twelve Shillings and seven Pence Halfpenny per Barrel; Wheat and Oats being the Corn principally grown in the said County of Cork. —
