Whereas a Certificate from the Parish of Kilmurry in the Diocese  
and County of Cork was lodged with the Registrar of the Justice  
Diocese, and now appears and is Entered in the Registry of Justice  
Diocese in the Words and figures following to wit, "John Kildie  
"Commissioner duly appointed and Sworn Under and by Virtue of  
"an Act made in the Second and third Year of the Reign of His  
"Majesty King William the fourth Entitled An Act to Amend  
"three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and sixth and  
"Eighth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the  
"Fourth providing for the Establishing of Compositions for Tithes in  
"Ireland and to make such Compositions permanent, to Ascertain  
"and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising  
"growing Yielded or payable within the Parish of Kilmurry  
"in the County of Cork do hereby certify that the true and just  
"Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever within said  
"Parish of Kilmurry is Eight Hundred and thirty five Pounds  
"Seven Shillings and One penny by the Year, which Sum is due  
"and payable to His Grace the Duke of Devonshire as a  
"Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as lay Proprietor  
"of said Parish, and I do further certify that the average price  
"of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in said County  
"during the period of the Seven Years ending the first day of  
"November One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirty is One  
"pound twelve Shillings and One half penny per Barrel and  
"that the Average price of Oats during the same period is twelve
