Kilcummal in the County of Cork, do certify hereby that
the true and just amount of Composition for all said
Tithes within the said parish is One hundred and sixty
one Pounds by the year of which sum of £. 161 the entire
is due and payable to Rev. Henry C. Harris as a
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him as owner of
the Rectorial and Vicarial Tithes of said Parish
