

be the very Reverend John French and Reverend William Radcliffe Smith Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an act made in the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Second entitled "An Act to provide for the Establishing of Compositions for Tythes in Ireland for a limited time" - to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all tythes arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Kilnamana in the County of Roscommon do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all Vicarial Tythes whatever within the said Parish is Forty one pounds Sterling by the year which said sum of Forty one pounds is due and payable to the Reverend Charles Smith as Vicar of the said Parish - And we do further Certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally grown in said County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November one thousand eight hundred and twenty one is fourteen shillings and two pence half penny per Bushel - Given under our hands this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight
