 to Henry Bentley Esq. of Glendon in said County as a Composition for the
 tithes Claimable by him on the part of the Rev. Standish Grady Rector
 of said parish. And we do further Certify that the true and just
 amount of Composition for all the Vicarial tithes within said parish
 is One hundred and two pounds five Shillings and four pence by the year
 which sum is due and payable to the Rev. Thomas M. Cullagh Vicar
 of said parish as a Composition of the tithes Claimable by him of said
 parish October 27th 1825
