George the fourth, entitled "An Act to provide  
for the establishing of Compositions for  
Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time, to  
ascertain & fix a true & just Composition for  
all Tithes arising, growing, yielded, or payable,  
within the Parish of Kilanvar, in the County of  
Down, do hereby certify, that the true & just  
Amount of Composition, for all Tithes whatever,  
within the said Parish is two hundred Pounds  
by the Year, of which Sum of two hundred Pounds  
one half are due & payable to Mr Peter Chute  
Lefson to the Very Rev. Dean Holmes, as a Com-  
position for the Tithes claimable by him, as Rector  
of the said Parish, and the other one half is due  
and payable to the Rev. Prot. Newson, the Vicar  
as Owner of the Vicarial Tithes of the said Parish.  
And We do further certify, that the Average Price  
of Wheat & Oats, (being the Corn principally grown  
in such County) for the Period of seven Years, ending  
on the 1st Day of November 1821 is Wheat 1. 18. 1/2  
and Oats 15. 2/6 per Barrel
