 of an act made in the fourth year of the reign of King George  
 the fourth Entitled an act to provide for the Establishing  
 of Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and  
 fix a true & just Composition for all Tithes arising  
 growing yielding and payable within the Parish of  
 Kilmoughtin in the County of Kerry do hereby Certi-  
 fy that the true and just amount of Composition for  
 all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is the  
 sum of two hundred and sixty-seven pounds nine  
 shillings <sup>and</sup> four pence halfpenny by the year twelfth  
 of amounting to the sum of one hundred & seven-  
 ty eight pounds six shillings & three pence being the Tithes due  
 and payable to the Rev<sup>d</sup> Fitzmaurice Sanders as holding  
 the Tithes of said twelfth by Lease and the remaining  
 third part thereof amounting to the sum of Eighty nine  
 pounds three shillings & three halfpence being the Tithes  
 due and payable to Mungumy Groun Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> as holding  
 the Tithes of said third by Lease -

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat  
 being the Corn together with Oats principally grown in  
 such County for the period of seven years ending the 29<sup>th</sup>  
 day of September last is £1<sup>s</sup> 5<sup>d</sup> per barrel of twenty stone  
 being at the rate of 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>3</sub> <sup>d</sup> per stone and that the average price  
 of Oats being the Corn also principally grown in such  
 County for the said period of seven years ending the 29<sup>th</sup>  
 day of September last is 13<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> <sup>d</sup> per barrel - of twenty stone
