Ireland for a limited time to Ascertain &  
fix a time & just Composition for all  
Tithes, Arising, Growing, yet due, or Payable  
within the Parish of Kilmahine, County of  
Wexford, do hereby certify, that the true & just  
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is Four Hundred & Seventy  
two pounds three Shillings & two pence half penny  
by the year - which Sum of Four Hundred &  
Seventy two pounds three Shillings and two pence  
half penny is due & payable to the Rev. Peter Brown  
Dean of Fern as a Composition for the Tithes  
claimable by him as Rector of the said Parish.

And we do further certify, that the average price  
of Wheat, being the corn principally grown in said  
County for the period of seven years ending on the first day  
of November 1821 was - is one pound eighteen Shillings  
and eight pence of Bessel - Given under our hands  
this 16th day of Novemb
