

and passed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years of the Reign of his present Majesty King William the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled "An Act to amend 3 Acts passed respectively in the 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup> providing for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to make Compositions permanent and also in virtue of an Act made and passed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> year of his present Majesty entitled "An Act for the relief of the owners of Tithes in Ireland, and for the amendment of an Act passed in the last Session of Parliament intituled an Act to amend three Acts passed in the 4<sup>th</sup> 5<sup>th</sup> and in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> years of the Reign of his late Majesty King George the 4<sup>th</sup> providing for the Establishment of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions permanent, upon your performing the matters and things prescribed and enacted by the said Acts to be done and performed on your part - and which said Estates are as follows, that is to say, the Townlands, or part of the Town Lands of Cammermead, and bounded on the East by the old Deer park, on the North with the Lands of Cammerdiffe, on the West with the County of Wicklow, and on the South with Bricks town, also the Town Lands or part of the Town Lands and Lands of Ballynacoola Ballygullen, and Braam mead and bounded on the West by the River Lash on the South by the River Bann, on the North by the Lands of Slagbawn and Moneyseed and on the East by the Lands of Syraw Ballyowen Ballygarrell and Hillmickel and the Town Lands or part of the Town Lands and Lands of Anaght Mangon and Bolany mead and bounded on the East and South with the River Bann, and the Lands of Clourou and Mount Nebo, and on the North and West with the Lands of Conahill Ballyluth and Slagbawn a certain lying and being in the parish of Kilsheen in the County of Wicklow, first deducting therefrom the 15. per Centum, on the amount as provided

provided by the said Acts, and I hereby on behalf of said infant require you in pursuance of the provisions of said Acts to grant to me on behalf of said infant with all convenient speed a Certificate under your hand and Seal of the import required by the said Acts, in order that I may on behalf of said infant execute under my hand and Seal the Declaration of the import required by the said Acts in manner therein directed, and I give you notice on behalf of said infant, that the said Infant is the Chief Landlord or lessor of the said lands and premises, and that I on behalf of said infant am ready to grooved give you any further information in relation thereto which you may require, upon receiving any notice from you, for that purpose.
