whatsoever within the said Parish is One Hundred and Thirty
five pounds Sterling by the Year of which sum of One
Hundred and Thirty five Pounds, Twenty five Pounds, are
due and payable to Mr Sandham Symes, ^{as} Composition
for the Tythe claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial
Tythes, and Sixty pounds are due and payable to Mr Ralph
Cummin the Vicar And we do further Certify that
the Average price of Oats being ~~the~~ the Corn Principally
Grown in said County, for the period of seven years,
ending on the first Day of November 1821 is fifteen
Shillings and two pence Farthing per Barrel
