of Kilmar in the County of Clare, do hereby certify that the  
true and just amount of composition for all tithes whatever  
within the said Parish is two hundred and twelve pounds  
six shillings and nine pence farthing <sup>by the year</sup> of which sum  
ninety two pounds six shillings and three half pence  
is due and payable to the Rev. Francis Synge, as a  
composition for the tithe claimable by him as Rector of the  
said Parish and that the sum of One hundred and one  
pounds ten shillings and eleven pence half penny  
British is due and payable to the Rev. W. Butler  
as a composition for the tithe claimable by him as the  
Vicar of said Parish, and that the sum of eighteen  
pounds nine shillings and eight pence (British),  
is due and payable to the Rev. W. Reed as a composition  
for the tithe claimable by him as Prebend of Tomquinn  
and we do further certify that the average
