

By the Justices assigned to keep
the Peace in and for the County of Cork at a
General Quarter Sessions of the Peace holden at
Cork in and for the Division of Cork and
County of Cork on the twenty third day of
September One thousand eight hundred and
fifty four

Whereas due notice of application having been first affixed
at the times and in the manner directed by the Statutes in such Case made
and provided by George Francis Hodder, Thomas William
Hungerford, Thomas Forsayeth, Thomas Achilles Deunt, and
Isaac Seymour Owners of Land in the Parish of Kilpatrick in the Diocese
and County of Cork and Division of Cork and Cork County East Riding
Each Charged with the annual payment of the sum of Three pounds and upwards
in respect of the Rent Charge payable in lieu of the Composition for tithes within
said Parish made by the Certificate of Valentine Droune bearing date the
thirteenth day of December One thousand eight hundred and thirty three
and in pursuance of the Statute in such Case made and provided and whereby
the Gross amount of Composition for all tithes whatever in the said Parish was
Certified to be the annual sum of One hundred and twenty pounds the said several
Owners of Land made an application in Writing to the Justices of the Peace at the
Quarter Sessions above mentioned to have the coverage price of Wheat being the
Grain in the Certificate mentioned for the preceding Seven years in the
Statutes in that behalf mentioned enquired of and ascertained in order that
the said Composition for tithes and the Rent Charge in lieu of such
Composition might be diminished according to such average price as
Compared with the price of One pound, twelve Shillings and One half
penny being the price of Wheat as set forth in the said Certificate

And Whereas the said Applicants having appeared before the said
Justices at such Quarter Sessions no appearance having been made by or on
behalf of the party entitled to the said Rent Charge in lieu of tithes Composition
And the said Notice of application, Certificate and the average price
of Wheat as advertized in the Dublin Gazette for the said period of Seven
years having been proved ——— Now the said Justices Do
ascertain from the said Gazette that the coverage price of Wheat for
the said period of Seven years is One pound seven Shillings and one Penny
for each Barrell of Twenty Stone And the said Justices Do accordingly
Order and adjudge that the amount of said Composition for tithes in said
Parish and the Rent Charge payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished
in proportion to the difference between the said coverage price of One pound
