

barrel of 16 stone and it was ordered and adjusted that the amount of the said Composition in said Parish for the said impropriate tithes and the rent charge payable in lieu thereof should be increased in proportion to the difference ^{between} the said average price of 17/- sterling for the period of seven years and the average price of 12/- stated in the certificate of the Composition. And it was further ordered that the applotment of such Composition should be amended and increased accordingly and that said ~~rent~~ increase should take effect from the 1st day of November 1875.

And Whereas the average price of barley for the past seven years as appears from the Dublin Gazette is less by one tenth at least than the average price as set forth in the said certificate and order of the 20th June 1875.

Now take Notice that we being three persons in said Parish each charged with the annual payment of £3 and upwards in respect of the said rent charge in said Parish in lieu of such Composition will apply to the Justices assigned to keep the Peace in and for the County of Cork who shall be assembled at the General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be holden at Middleton in and for the Division of Middleton Cork County East Riding on the 20th day of October 1889 that the Composition for tithes in said Parish in lieu whereof the tithe rent charge in said Parish is payable and the said tithe rent charge may be diminished in proportion to the difference between the average price of said grain for the past seven years to be ascertained from the Dublin Gazette and the average price of 17/- stated

in said certificate and the Order of the 20th June 1875 and that the applotment of said composition may be amended accordingly and that if it should be deemed necessary that an Arbitrator be appointed pursuant to the ^{power} ~~power~~ given by the Fourth George II Chapter 99 section 43 to ascertain the average price of such grains as aforesaid from the Dublin Gazette for the last seven years and to report the same and to make the necessary adjournment for the report and upon such report that such diminutions shall be made in such tithe rent charge as shall be fit.
