

Honors of Lylches in Ireland, and for the amendment
of an act passed in the last session of Parliament
entituled "An act to amend 3 acts passed respectively
in the 4th, 5th and in the 7th and 8th years of the reign
of his late Majesty King George the fourth, providing
for the Establishment of Compositions for Lylches in
Ireland, and to make such Compositions perpetual
upon your performing, the matters and things prescribed
and enacted by the said acts to be done & performed on
your part, and which Statutes are as follows, that is to
say, the town lands, or part of the town lands and lands
of Monalee and Clowrow situated and bounded on the East
by the lands of Brosham, on the South by the lands of
Tuiabaw and Balace, on the West by the lands of Arough
and on the North by the lands of Ballythomas, all
situate, lying and being in the Parish of Kilmear, in the
County of Wexford, and also out of the townlands, a part
of the town lands and lands of Wraigfield, Barndam,
Kallinabarney, Ballythomas, and Craane, situated
and bounded on the East and North by the County of
Wicklow, and the Commons of Monalee, on the South
by the Commons of Monalee, Clowrow, Monalee, and
Craakill, and on the West, by the lands of Loggan
all situate, lying and being in the half parish
of Kilpiper, and said County of Wexford, first deducting
therefrom the 5th per centum on the amount as
provided by the said acts. And I hereby on behalf
of said Infant request you in pursuance of the
provisions of said acts to grant to me, on behalf
of said Infant, with all convenient speed a
Certificate under your hand and seal of the
import required by the said acts, in order that
I may on behalf of said Infant execute under
my hand and seal, the Declaration of the import
required by the said acts in manner therein
directed. And I give you notice on behalf of
said Infant, that the said Infant is the
Chief Landlord or lessor seized in fee simple of
the Rent and reversion of all said lands and
parishes

premises, and that I on behalf of said Infant am
ready to give you any further information in relation
thereto which you may require upon receiving any
notice from you for that purpose.
